Dear Mr. Sexton:

This letter is regarding the Salmon Salvage Project Decision Notice and Finding of No Significant Impact that I signed on July 24, 2014. In exchange for you agreeing not to file a legal complaint challenging my decision, I have agreed to remove the following units from the timber sale:

- unit 345
- the salvage-only portion of unit 285, and
- the Late-Successional Reserve portion of unit 353.

Please confirm that this is your understanding of our agreement.

In order to make the potential bidders aware of the changes to the timber sale, we are calling them individually concerning the revisions. We are also putting a notice in the paper indicating that the sale package is being withdrawn and will be substituted with another package and that the bid opening will be extended.

I have agreed to implement the above changes because I believe it is in the best interest of the public we serve to implement this project in a timely manner. Our agreement to modify the sale does not constitute a change to my decision and is not subject to further public comment or administrative review.
